



Stream 2: Challenging a Level

For candidates seeking to challenge a level within the farriery certification program, an opportunity exists to demonstrate proficiency and accelerate their progression. With three levels available for challenge (Year 1, 2 or 3), as well as the final exam, candidates have flexibility in choosing the appropriate level based on their skills and experience.

To qualify, candidates must pass the exam corresponding to the level they wish to attain. For those aiming to challenge the final exam, a minimum of three years of full-time farriery experience is required ensuring candidates possess a comprehensive understanding of the profession. Additionally, obtaining membership with a supporting regional association is essential, providing candidates with access to resources and community support.

In the event of an unsuccessful attempt, candidates will be placed at the level below the exam they challenged, allowing for continued growth and development within the program.
